Triage Dialog Practice From BC-1002 Search and Triage – Indoors

(Use your name in place of Amy)

CERT Member: Hi, I'm with the Emergency Response Team, my name is Amy, What's your name?

Victim: My name is Bob. I think my leg is broken

CERT Member: Ok, Bob, someone will be along shortly to provide medical treatment, in the meantime, I need to assess you so that we can get you the right medical help. Can I check you over?

Victim: Yes

< Check Respiration while talking to the victim.>

CERT Member: I'm going to squeeze your finger, OK?

Victim: OK.

CERT Member: Now I want you to squeeze my hand. Good. I'm going to put a yellow clip on you, to identify that you are injured. Someone will be along shortly to provide medical help. Please lie down and try to remain calm.
